At my suggestion you talked with the Finance Commissioner regarding loss to the amount of \$514.70 on loans made through the Commissioner of Agriculture under the provisions of Chapter 5, P&SL 1935.

The Finance Commissioner saw me today and we have reached the conclusion that this balance should be charged off against the interest and profit earned on these loans and should not be charged to the appropriation to the Department of Agriculture.
