To W. H. Deering, Treasurer, Augusta State Hospital

After examining the memo from H. H. Harris, Controller, . . . and after my conference with you and Dr. Sleeper relating to a bill for \$1358.24 for lumber purchased from Hoyt Bros., Augusta, Maine, for the Augusta State Hospital, which bill is accompanied by purchase order dated June 17, 1947, it is my opinion that this bill does not come within the purview of council order No. 133, dated June 20, 1945, which limits the repair of state-owned buildings to \$1000, in view of the fact that this lumber was bought for inventory purposes. I am approving the bill.
