To Carl T. Russell, Deputy Commissioner, Labor and Industry
Re: Wages and time of payment, summer camp.

I have your memo of September 29th, in which you state that you enclose an excerpt from a letter from H.C. Fielding, Executive Secretary, Agassiz Village of the Burroughs Newsboys Foundation, relating to the provisions of Section 38 of Chapter 25, R.S. 1944, as to whether or not it applies to a non-profit welfare organization. You ask for a ruling upon this matter.

It is my opinion that since the Agassiz Village of the Newsboys Foundation is conducting a summer camp, it is within the purview of our Maine statute, Section 38, Chapter 25, R.S. 1944.
