Receipt is acknowledged of your memo of October 16th relative to Frank H. Kent, who by legislative Resolve, Chapter 54, 1947, was made eligible to have the benefits of the provisions of Sections 212 et sequitur of Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes of 1944. You assumed evidently that these provisions were repealed by the provisions of Chapter 384, P. L. 1947; but the pertinent provisions, which were Sections 212-214 inclusive, were not repealed but incorporated in and made a part of Chapter 384. In other words these sections were continued in effect, and thus the Resolve did not create any inconsistency.
