To Roland H. Cobb, Commissioner, Inland Fisheries and Game  
Re: Sale of Surplus of Booklet Entitled "Fish of Maine"

Question: Can the surplus of the booklet entitled "Fish of Maine" be sold and, if so, under what conditions and at what price?

Answer: If the initial Council Order authorizing the publication and printing of the booklet "Fish of Maine" does not limit or restrict the distribution and sale of said booklet, or does not authorize the sale thereof, and the Governor and Council by proper order shall now approve and authorize the sale of such surplus, fixing the price thereof, there is no legal objection to the sale of such surplus of the booklet entitled "Fish of Maine".
