In response to your memo of June 11, 1951, we refer you to the following statutes, which are pertinent to your questions as to the legality of pinball games and raffles:

511, ch. 126, R.S. 1944. Note: Pinball machines and slotemachines have been considered to be within the same category. 54 C. J.S. 853, n. 18.
