In response to your memo of June 11, 1951, we refer you to the following statutes, which are pertinent to your questions as to the legality of pinball games and raffles:

§11, ch. 126, R.S. 1944. Note: Pinball machines and slot machines have been considered to be within the same category.
54 C. J.S. 853, n. 18.

§18, ch. 126, R.S. 1944.

These statutes are self-explanatory and we feel that an opinion as to the legality of pinball games and raffles, in the face of these statutes, is unnecessary.
