To Daris M. St, Pierre, Secretary, Real Estate Commission Re: Maiden Name as Trade Name

. . You ask if a married woman may use her maiden name as a trade name in her activities relative to real estate.

While we have ruled that such a license may not be issued in a maiden name, the use of the maiden name as a trade name is not in conflict with our laws.
