To Earle R. Hayes, Secretary, Maine State Retirement System Re: Employees, Cary Memorial Hospital

In answer to your memo of June 2, 1952, it is the opinion of this office, after having considered the letters attached to your memo, from Clinton Clauson, Collector of Internal Revenue, and the excerpts of statutes relative to Cary Memorial Hospital, that this hospital is an instrumentality of the State and as such is eligible to participate in the benefits extended by the Social Security Act and the Agreement entered into between the State of Maine and the Federal Government.
