Re: Liability in Case of Accidents

In a letter dated July 28th, Gerald L. Saunders, Director 2 for Oxford County at Hebron, wrote inquiring as to who would be liable in case of accident at the tower on the roof of the reception cottage at the Sanatorium.

It appears that there is no liability either for the State or, as far as this office is informed, the Federal Government.

This work, being done on a volunteer basis, should also be done with great caution.
