Re: Windshields decals

You raise the question as to the legality of affixing Civil Defense stickers to automobile windshields.

This office has consulted with the Deputy Secretary of State under whose jurisdiction come motor vehicles, and it is his opinion and ours that it would be permissible to affix such stickers in the lower right hand corner of the windshield, where such stickers would not substantially obscure the vision of the driver.
