Cobb, Commissioner Inland Fisheries and Game Re: License Fund Replying to yours of November 12th to this office:-We note the circumstances in the case of John Sica, No. 22734, and there is not precedent in the law for refund of such license fee. Any return of the money in this case could not be taken as a precedent to be followed in any other case; but it would appear that under the circumstances you would be well justified in securing the return of the umused license, canceling same, and returning the money to Mr. Sica who had this unfortunate accident, preventing him from using the license.
