To Earle R. Hayes, Secretary, Maine State Retirement System Re: Maine Municipal Association

. . . Under Section 2 of Chapter 395 of the Public Laws of 1951, the term "political subdivision" is defined to include associations of municipalities. It is our opinion that the Maine Municipal Association, an organization in which the municipalities are associated, having been incorporated as a body corporate and politic and being for that reason a juristic entity, is eligible to participate in the benefits under the provisions of Chapter 395.
