To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with Section 25 of Chapter 15, Revised Statutes of the State of Maine, a Commissioner of the Treasury is appointed to perform the duties of the office of Treasurer of State temporarily when a vacancy in that office occurs.

The term of such Commissioner terminates when a

Treasurer is duly elected by the Legislature, and the said Treasurer
may thereupon legally sign any document registered in the name of a

Commissioner of the Treasury.
