To Roland H. Cobb, Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game  
Re: Bulldozing of Stream

We are returning herewith the correspondence on Twenty-Mile Brook in which, according to your Regional Biologist's report, the Great Northern Paper Company is conducting operations in Aroostook County in violation of Section 16-A of Chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes. You ask what action your department should take, if any.

Violation of Section 16-A is a misdemeanor and if your department ascertains such to be the fact, steps should be taken as indicated in said section, by presenting the matter to the County Attorney of Aroostook County for prosecution.
