To Carole A. Levesque, Clerk of Travel Bureau  
Re: Request of Phoenix-London Group

We have your letter of January 6, 1954, in the following tenor:

"As requested by the Phoenix-London Group, effective immediately, will you please be sure that the age of the operator is incorporated on all automobile accident report forms submitted. It is necessary that they have this information for statistical purposes."

It would appear that the request of the Phoenix-London Group more properly comes within the administration of the Insurance Department than that of the office of the Attorney General. We do not supply these forms, and if it is desirable that accident reports include the age of the operator, we would suggest that a directive from your department be sent to the departments involved.
