We are returning herewith correspondence from the Federal Trust Company and attached assignment of contract executed by Clyde L. Chaney and the Federal Trust Company of Waterville, Maine, also copies of contract and surety bond relating to the installation of steam generating and domestic hot water system at the Women's Reformatory, Skowhegan.

We would advise that you do not agree to the assignment until such time as the surety company consents to such assignment. The possibility that the surety may be discharged from its obligations because of such assignment compels us to the above advice.
