Your letter with respect to an incident wherein an employee is poisoned by the consumption of food served by his employer has just come to my attention.

Mr. Donahue, the Assistant Attorney General who handles the State's Industrial Accident cases, advises me that the cases with which he is familiar indicate that the employer is liable, provided he is an assenting employer under the Act, because the circumstances are deemed to be accidental. . . .
