To Lawrence F. Decker, Chief Engineer, Inland Fisheries and Game
Re: Right of Way at Embden Pond

I have considered your memorandum of September 11th and think it best that the exchange of location of right of way be made by authority of a Resolve to be had when the next legislature convenes.

Section 8 of the Inland Fisheries and Game Laws provides that the Governor and Council may sell certain properties not longer needed by the Department, but this is restricted to the interest of the State in property taken by purchase and seems not to apply to property acquired by gift as in this case.
