Statutes pertaining to the examining boards

Under date of March 18, 1958, you wrote this office setting forth in full Chapter 82, Section 134 and Chapter 82A, Section 16 of our Maine laws and asking three questions in regard to the cited sections.

Question No. 1:

"Would it be contrary to the provisions of the above sections for the Insurance Commissioner to charge the boards for additional amounts for salaries and travel of state fire inspectors in excess of the 20% limitation?"

The answer is:

Yes, it would be contrary to the provisions of the cited statutes.

Question No. 2:

"Would it be proper for the Insurance Commissioner to charge the boards for a month's salary of the Director of State Fire Prevention?"

The answer is:

No, it would not be a proper charge.

Question No. 3:

"Would it be proper for the Insurance Commissioner to charge the boards for mileage for a Departmental Garage car at the rate of eight cents per mile, when the Insurance Department had paid only five cents per mile for the use of this car?"

The answer is:

No, it would not be proper.
