Subject: Residence of Louise Gerry

I have your request for an epinion regarding the residence for school purposes of the above-named party and the reasons for the request of your department.

Based on the facts supplied to me it appears that until December 15, 1957, the father was a resident of Bombon. From that sected until after school closed, he maintained a home at a trailer park in Finalow, Maine, with the exception of a two-mouth period when he was on a trip, during which time he arranged for his daughter to stay with a relative in Pairfield.

Section 44 of Chapter 41. Revised Statutes of 1954, as amended, defines residence for the purposes of Chapter 41

". . . the administrative unit where the father maintains a home for his family."

It is my epinion that the father maintained a home in Winslow after leaving Senten and the daughter vegic therefore be entitled to be adminted in Winslow during the period in question. There seems to be a question of fact concerning when the father left menton (Reventer 17, 1957, or becomber 15, 1987), but in sither case the residence for achool surpasses from the date of departure from Menton until the end of the school year was Vinslow. It may be necessary to determine the exact date of departure fact Menton to determine state subsidy physicals for the administrative units involved.
