Children on Federal Reservations

Residence in general is defined by Section 44 as the administrative unit where the father maintains a home for his family. Section 163 provides for schooling of children on a government reservation. Please refer to memorandum of Pebruary 5, 1957, by James Clynn Frost, Doputy Attorney General re Children of Military Forecasel".

In regard to the memorandum of Jume 4, 1943, written by Attorney General Genera, I can see no statutory enactment which would alter the conclusion contained therein. I assume that the federal government still provides payments in lies of taxes.
