Rivised Statutes of 1950, Chapter 10, Section 7, Legislative Document So. 1203, it is my epinion that the striking out of the word "service" in the third line of that bill and the adding of the words "through the State Dureau of Purchases, arrange for necessary service, "would require you to arrange for accretions, which would include printing, outside the State Dureau of Purchases, It is my understanding that at this time you do arrange for your printing service through the Bureau.

The balance of the amendment seems clear enough by simply adding more to your duties.
