Dear Senator Charles:

In answer to your oral inquiry as to the validity of Chapter 93 of the Revised Statutes of 1954 as amended, it is our opinion that this law entitled "Maine Housing Authorities" was properly enacted in 1949 and became a valid, operating statute. It has been amended several times, and any proper amendment passed by this session of the Legislature would be to a valid existing law.
