Candy Packaging and Wrapping

I have your request for our opinion on whether or not a plant which sorts and packages candies is an industrial project.

Referring to Paragraph III of Section 5, Chapter 38-B, Revised Statutes of 1954, the definition of "industrial project" is set out. Please refer to my opinion of March 31, 1958, for guides in making a factual determination.

It appears from the information available that this operation does not fit the definition of processing or assembling of raw materials or manufactured products and therefore is not eligible for insurance under the act.
