Incompatibility

Dear Mr. Thebeau:

It has recently come to my attention that you currently hold the position of Jury Commissioner from Sagadahoc County as well as the chairmanship of the Bath Board of Registration of Voters. Under the provisions of Chapter 3, Section 11, Revised Statutes of Maine of 1954, no person may be a member of the Board of Registration and at the same time serve as a county official.

Upon advice from the Office of the Attorney General concerning this apparent incompatibility of offices, I have decided to write this letter to you so that you can have the opportunity of resigning from one or the other of these positions so as to comply with the provision of the above law.

I will expect to hear from you at your convenience with regard to this matter.
