You have asked our opinion as to whether or not the hiring of an industrial agent by the Washington County Commissioners, with EED approval, meets with the provisions of Chapter 314 of the Public Laws, 1961.

Our answer is No. Chapter 314, Public Laws 1961, is clear that the Department of Economic Development may assign personnel to Washington County to aid in planning its industrial growth and development at the request of the County Commissioners. It is our opinion that the personnel referred to shall be state personnel employed by EED and covered by state personnel law.
