Bestruction of Records

There is no Statute of Limitations as such on modical records. Such records are covered along with other State records in the following section of the laws

Chapter 1, Son. 35, Reviewd Statutes of Heine, 195k, Destruction of Records:

'The old records of any State department which is the opinion of the head of such department are no longer of value to the State may be destroyed upon approval in writing of the Atterney General, State inditor, Consideriosor of Finness and Administration, and the State Historian; but not otherwise, provided however, that if any all record appears to have sufficient value, approval to destroy shall be withheld until said ald moord has been capied at the expense of the State by any photostatic, photographic microfilm or other process which produces a clear, accurate and permanent copy or reproduction there of and estisfactory provision is made for the permanent storage of such copies or reproductions is fireproof containers.'

Since it is your intention to misrofilm your old medical records I suggest that you pressed with the misrofilming and then have the Commissions's apply to the proper officials for approval of the destruction of the original records.
