Lease of Rights to construct and maintain a road ever land situate at Stevens Training Center.

One, Stubbs of Hallowell, intending to purchase a parcel of land adjacent to the property of the Stevens Training Center desires to know a method by which he can construct a road leading from Pleasant Street, over the land of the Stevens Training Center, to the parcel of adjoining land.

Proceeding under Section 12 of Chapter 36, Asyland Statutes of Malme, 1954, as amended by Chapter 185, Public Lame of 1957 and Chapter 8, Public Lame of 1961, the Forestry Commissioner may lease under the direction of the Governor and Chaptel rights to construct and maintain mode on lands belonging to the State, professor in such leases being given to parsons, firms, and corporations of this State.

It is my opinion that Mr. Stubbs should negotiate with Commissioner Asstin Wilking for the lease of the desired strip of land at the Stevens Training Center with a view to construction of the road leading to his proposed bosse let.
