You have requested my spinion as to the sufficiency of the following delegation of authority under the specifications:

"At a smoting of the Board of Directors of the Constructors Incorporated held on Friday Feb. 9, 1962 at which all the Directors were present or waived notice, it was

VOTED, that J. J. Waldage, President of this Company, be and he is authorised to execute contracts and beneds in the mass and behalf of said Company, and affix its comparate seal thereto; and such expention of any contract or obligation in the Company's name on its behalf by such J. J. Waldage, under seal of the Company, shall be valid and binding upon this Company."

This authorises the President specifically to sign contracts and bonds, and further states that execution of contracts and obligations by him shall be binding.

The use of "bonds" in see part and "obligations" in the latter part shows that the intent of the Directors was to give the President full powers to find the Company. The word "obligations" is a bread term, and means anything that would bind the Company.

It is true that specific power to sign proposals was not sectioned, but the broad over-all authority to obligate the Company gives power to obligate the Company in the matter of the proposal.
