I am returning the above contract without approval for execution. After talking with Mr. Ames with relation to this contract, I recommend that the second paragraph read as follows:

"The number of films in this series shall be 10 films or such lesser number as is determined by the Commissioner, Maine Department of Education. The length of each film shall be between 20 and 30 minutes and the approximate cost of each film shall be \$1,000.00, said cost being dependent upon the length and subject of each film. The total cost of the series shall not exceed \$10,000.00"

A letter from the Commissioner of Education with Mr. Hanson's signature d/b/a Headlight Film Service on the letter as returned will be a sufficient contract.
