Re: State Subsidy on Capital Expenditures

Your memorandum of February 11, 1963, is answered below:

A restatement of citations is required. No change of principle results, however.

Please effect a change in the second paragraph so that it reads as follows:

"United States Code, Title 20, Sections 631 through 645, provides for federal grant-in-aid for the purpose of providing assistance for the construction of minimum school facilities in areas impacted with federal employees."
