Re: L. D. 1417 - An Act Authorizing the Maine Port Authority
to Establish Foreign Trade Zones in Maine.

You have asked this office if lobster meat would come within the definition of the words "goods, wares and merchandise" in the above legislative document. It is the opinion of this office that lobster meat is "goods, wares and merchandise" as those words are used in the above legislative document. It should be pointed out that the sale of lobster meat after being processed in a foreign trade zone would then be subject to State laws regarding its sale and distribution in the State.
