Employment of Impates and Prisoners on Public Works Projects, and other Employment Outside Enstitutions.

#### PACTS

The Department of Mental Health and Corrections may authorize the employment of immates of the Referentery for Men and Frisoners of the Maine State Frison, on work projects without the confines of eatd institutions.

#### OBEST ON

I. By Statute must the employment of immetes of the Reformatory for Men, outside the institution, be only on Fubite Works projects taking place on property sumed or supervised by the State of Hainel

#### OFINAM:

1. R.S. 1954, c. 27, 43-A is in part as follows:

"The department may authorise the amployment of abla-bodied prisoners in the State prison or immites of the Referencery for Men in the seastfuction and improvement of highways or other public works within the State under such arrangements as may be unde with the State Highway Commission of other department or seamination of the State having such public works in charge, and said department may prescribe such foles and conditions as it doesn expedient to insure the proper care and treatment of the prisoners or insure the proper care and treatment of the prisoners or insure while so employed and their infektoping and return. The department may further authorize the training and use of shie-bodied prisoners in the State Frison or insules in the Referencery for Non by the State Forestry Department or the Department of Civil Defense and Public Sefety to fight fires or provide assistance during or after any civilian disaster."

The suployment of reformatory immates under the Provisions of \$3-A, on Public Works projects in charge of Departments of State Government must be on property senied or supervised by the State, since Public Works in charge of State Departments exist only on property owned or supervised by the State.

"The term 'Public Works' means 'all fixed works constructed for public use as railways, docks, canals, water-works, roads, etc." 35-A Words and Phrases, Public Work, Page 124.
