Although, the bonds when issued, are to provide for "countraction, repairs, equipment, supplies and furnishings" the broad glassifications are covered by the total amount of the authorized band issue 18,622,000, and the "broad farms" are of little essistances in a determination of the extent to which an immitted alloquation of funds as found to 16 of the ast might be used.

It is, therefore, our opinion that the limiting language of the quoted portion of \$6 demands strict construction. This opinion is strongthened by provice that the funds raised by the lamance of bonds are to be ablely, for the purposes set forth in the Act.

It is our opinion that to use the \$300,000 allocated for renovations to ward buildings in order to affect remodeling of buildings for employed competion, would be a disposition of the funds not contemplated by the legislature, or by the retifying voters, and in violation of the purposes of the Ast.
