Firemanship Training Schools

FACTS:

A program of fireman training is conducted by the State Board of Education; and the program is administered by the Board. R. S., c. 41, § 218-D and 218-E. A request has been made of the Board that it hold training sessions on Sunday. The request has been submitted by firemen who hold regular jobs during week days; and who have stated that it would be more convenient to meet on Sunday.

QUESTION:

Whether the holding of these classes on Sunday would constitute a violation of R. S., c. 134, § 38?

ANSWER:

No.

REASON:

R. S. 1954, c. 134, § 38 was last amended by P. L. 1963, c. 370. Instruction of firemen pursuant to P. L. 1963, c. 370 is not prohibited by the reference statute.
