Renting of Motor Vehicles by Dealers

You have been asked concerning the actions of some motor vehicle dealers in renting motor vehicles bearing the dealer's plates. Such action by a dealer is improper.

29 M.R.S.A. § 331 provides for the issuance of dealer plates "instead of registering each motor vehicle owned or controlled by him." It further states:

"Such certificate of registration shall . . . and all vehicles owned or controlled by such applicant shall be regarded as registered under such general distinguishing number, color or mark <u>until</u> sold, exchanged or <u>operated for hire.</u>" (Emphasis supplied).

A motor vehicle rented by a dealer to another person is "operated for hire." Hence, such a motor vehicle is not registered under the dealer registration.
