Dear Mr. Powers:

This is to acknowledge your letter of July 7 addressed to the Attorney General, which letter was forwarded to my desk for attention and reply.

In accordance with the provisions of Administrative Bulletin No. 193 and 321 prepared and executed by the State Highway Commission, your position as constable and deputy sheriff would not be compatible with your continued employment by the State Highway Department. This is an administrative determination, Public Law 89-554, otherwise known as the Hatch Act on law relating to political activity of State employees.

The administrative determination is based on compatibility.
