The fac 12 M.R.S.A. § 4801 as enacted by P.L. 1969, c. 365 § 1 ar inded by P.L. 1971, c. 532, §§ 1, 2, the Minimum Lot Size Law, the cititled "Not served by public sewer or water supply" while he takete does not elsewhere concern itself with "water supply" has boolutely no affect upon the meaning and applicability the Minimum Lot Size Law.

### FACTS

The Mill . M. Lot Size Law, 12 M.R.S.A. SS 4801 4806 (P.L. 1969, c. 36. 1 as amended by P.L. 1971, c. 532), hereinafter called the a cure, nowhere speaks of "water supply" except that \$'4801 is entired by public sewer or water supply".

### QUESTION:

Does the tature apply to subdivisions served with public sewers but was at all by public water supplies?

#### ANSWER:

No.

#### REA SONING:

The slow of the words "water supply" in the title to \$ 4801 is viviously a drafting error in view of the fact that the statute nearly like speaks of "water supply". The phrase "water supply" is at title to \$ 4801 should be disregarded and the statute applied of \$ 100% rear not served by a public or private community; sewer 100%.
