Re: Indian Hunting Licenses

Dear Hayes:

This is in reply to your letter of November 16, 1973, concerning the eligibility of your constituent, Roger Chouteau, to receive a free hunting, trapping and fishing license.

The law to which Commissioner Stevens of Indian Affairs seems to have referred, is P.L. 1971, Chapter 92, by virtue of which a member of the Association of Aroostook Indians who is over the age of 10 years and who has resided in the State of Maine for at least 5 years may receive such a license from the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries & Game. A copy of Chapter 92 is enclosed.
