Subject Title 29 §1368(2)

Referring to your inquiry of February 21, research has revealed no compelling reason in law why part-time police officers may not equip their own vehicles with blue police lights for police use only. Although the statute speaks of lights used on police department vehicles, it also refers to vehicles operated by various law enforcement officers. Therefore, no legislative intent to restrict the use of blue lights to department vehicles can be inferred from this statute.
