This replies to your June 25, 1974 memorandum inquiring on this subject.

It appears that on June 19, 1972, the Board of Trustees, Maine State Retirement System, entered into a contract with the Putnam Advisory Company, Inc., whereby, the latter agreed to provide investment management and administration of the funds of the Retirement System. It now appears that there has been a substantial corporate reorganization of the Putnam Companies, whereby, the investment management of the Retirement System funds will continue to be done by the Putnam Advisory Company, Inc., but the investment administration will be by Putnam Advisory Services, Inc. There has been a rearrangement of inter-corporate relationships and shuffling of personnel.

You ask whether or not these changes indicate a need for a new investment advisory contract. The answer to that question is affirmative. The corporate entity with which the Retirement System contracted is now performing only a part of the contract and the remainder of the contract is being performed by a new corporate entity. In effect, this constitutes an assignment of a portion of the contract.

If I can be of any further aid to you in this matter, please advise me.
