Notice of suspension

Notification of suspension of license, etc., is governed by 29 M.R.S.A. § 2241, sub-§3, which provides for a letter to the registrant or licensee to the address given by him by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, with instructions to deliver to addressee only. Notification is complete when the return receipt is signed.

I am afraid that your newspaper notice would not be an acceptable substitute, and I recommend we do not try it.
