Subject Eligibility of Maine County Commissioners Association as a Participating District Under Chapter 622, Public Laws of 1975

Your memo of September 17, 1975, with attachments, asks if the Maine County Commissioners Association would be eligible to participate in the Maine State Retirement System under the provisions of 5 M.R.S.A. Section 1001, subsection 11A, as amended by Chapter 622, Public Laws of 1975.

The Maine County Commissioners Association as an incorporated association of eligible local districts is clearly a "local district" within the meaning of 5 M.R.S.A. § 1001-11-A as enacted by P.L. 1975, chap. 622 § 5.
