This responds to your opinion request of January 18, 1977, relating to proper disposition of fines collected under 7 M.R.S.A. § 3455. Please excuse our delay in responding. I believe that the proper disposition of fines collected in accordance with 7 M.R.S.A. § 3455 is specified by the provisions of 12 M.R.S.A. § 3061 which specifically provides that such fines accrue to the Treasurer of the State. Accordingly, it does not appear that such fines should accrue to the town where the violation occurs.
