Dear Senator Katz and Representative Najarian:

This is to advise you that in preparation of the opinion to you from this office dated September 12, 1977, it appears that two words were left out of the second full paragraph on the third page. On that page, the second sentence of the second full paragraph should read as follows:

Municipalities may only take such actions, however, if the expenditures are made pursuant to a local charter or ordinance provision specifically authorizing the expenditure.

You will note that at previous points in the opinion it refers to charter or ordinance provisions as necessary to approve the expenditure in question.
