Wildes has received sixty-one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one (61,861) votes; Rodney C. Penney has received sixty-one thousand nine hundred and three (61,903) votes; Charles H. Chase has received forty-eight thousand and twenty-four (48,024) votes; Albert W. Madigan has received forty-seven thousand three hundred and ninety-nine (47,399) votes; Daniel Cote has received forty-seven thousand four hundred and nine (47,409) votes; Isaac W. Sherman has received forty-seven thousand four hundred and twenty-four (47,424) votes; Samuel W. Gould has received forty-seven thousand four hundred and twenty-three (47,423) votes; Aaron L. Blaine has received (1) vote; Aaron Simpson has received sixteen (16) votes; and Charles Chase has received twenty (20) votes; and Thomas W. Hyde, of Bath, William M. Nash, of Cherryfield, West M. Goddall of Sanford, Sidney Perham of Paris, Asa W. Wildes, W. M. Moxthegan and Rodney C. Penney of Monson, having received the least number of votes returned as required by law, are declared Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States, on behalf of the State of Maine.
