I, MARKHAM L. GARTLEY, Secretary of State, certify that in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 86 of the Private and Special Laws of 1975, a Special Election was conducted in the northern portions of Townships 1 and 2, Range 1, N.B.K.P., (Rockwood Strip) on October 15, 1975, for the purpose of determining whether or not the residents of the unorganized territory would vote to incorporate into the Town of Rockwood.

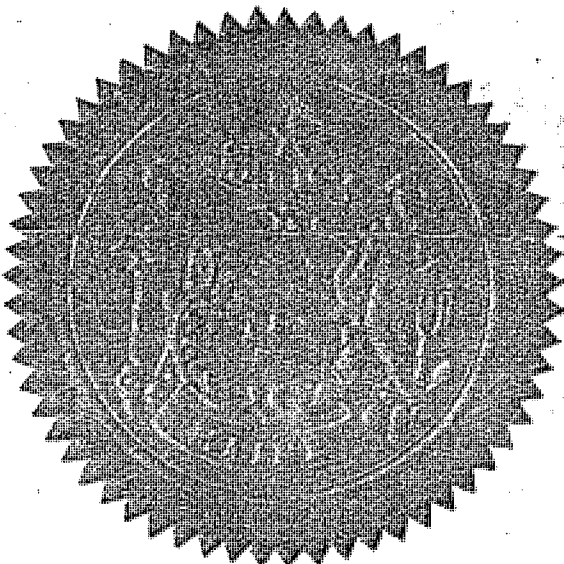
Said election was conducted in the same manner as local option elections in unorganized territory.

It was determined that the total number of qualified voters in the unorganized territory was 137.

The total number of votes cast was	<u>105</u>
The total number of "Yes" votes was	<u>14</u>
The total number of "No" votes was	<u>90</u>
The total number of Defective Ballots was	<u>1</u>

The "No" votes being more than 50% of the total number of qualified voters, the said unorganized territory, as of October 15, 1975, voted not to incorporate into the Town of Rockwood.

GIVEN under my hand at Augusta, this sixteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five and in the two hundredth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
