EXECUTIVE ORDER
GOVERNOR KENNETH M. CURTIS

We are all aware of the special relationship of the Indian Tribes and their reservation lands to the State of Maine. Specific responsibilities with corresponding appropriations are vested in certain agencies, particularly the Department of Indian Affairs, and the Department of Education, in regard to our Indian populations. Many other agencies work in one form or another with our Indian citizens. I wish to state that it is, and will continue to be, the policy of this Administration to give all possible assistance within budget and staff limitations to the Indians of the State, through whatever agencies are appropriate.
