EXECUTIVE ORDER
GOVERNOR KENNETH M. CURTIS

No. 3 FY 70
November 24, 1969

In order to expedite the processing of highway safety projects and other data pertaining to the Highway Safety Act of 1966 the following delegation of authority is hereby made.

Effective immediately and until further notice, Roger L. Mallar, Planning and Traffic Engineer of the Maine State Highway Commission is hereby designated Official Highway Safety Representative and is authorized to exercise the functions, powers, and duties vested in the Governor by law, relating to securing for the State of Maine the full benefits of the Highway Safety Act of 1966 (P.L. 89-564), including but not limited to the authority to enter into highway safety agreements with the Federal Government in behalf of the State.

Executive Order dated October 18, 1968 is hereby rescinded.
